



Dr. Al Ansari is a graduate of King Saud University in Riyadh where he specialized in English Language Studies. He later obtained his Masters Degree from Pittsburgh University in the United States, and his PhD from Southampton University in England. His academic pursuit never stopped at this point but continued in an exceptional academic and public career. He became Dean of the College of Technology at Dammam, and later Rector of Prince Mohammad Bin Fahd University in Al-Khobar. He is also Member of the Board of Directors of the educational services company "Taleem".

Dr. Issa is the author of many educational publications that range from articles, to research papers and studies, as well as a book entitled *"From Education to Work Youth Training and Employment"*.

Dr. Al Ansari has notable contributions in serving the community as Supervisor General of Prince Mohammad Bin Fahd Program for Youth Development, and as Chairman of the Educational and Social Committee in the Eastern Province Council in which he serves as member. Other memberships at the national level include membership of the Committee of Prince Mohammad Bin Fahd Prize for Scientific Distinction; and also he is the Secretary General of the Social Rehabilitation Committee and of the Community Development Council in the Eastern Province Governorate.
